Who can apply for funds

Individuals who, as a child, were in care in Queensland or lived in a Queensland institution.

What funding is available

Individuals can apply for funds to support their health and wellness, personal development or private or public dental treatment.

Who can apply for funds

Charitable organisations that serve and support people experiencing, or at risk of, homelessness.

What funding is available

DGR-1-eligible charities can apply for funds to help them provide tailored, practical assistance to people experiencing, or at risk of, homelessness.

Queensland Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Foundation (QATSIF)

Who can apply for funds

Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students who intend to complete their Queensland Certificate of Education or Queensland Certificate of Individual Achievement can apply through their school.

What funding is available

Students at high schools participating in the QATSIF Scholarship Program can receive a \$500-per-semester scholarship throughout Years 11 and 12 to assist with some costs of education.

Who can apply

Charitable organisations across a wide range of sectors.

What funding is available

DGR-1-eligible charities can apply for funds to help them build their capacity to support Queensland communities on the Gold Coast, Sunshine Coast, the Darling Downs, in North Queensland and the Gulf.

Charities can also apply for funds to support their work in areas including community wellbeing, health, arts and culture, animal welfare, children and youth, education, the environment, medical research, support for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples and religious endeavours.

As the trustee of the Forde Foundation, the Lady Bowen Trust, the Queensland Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Foundation and the Queensland Community Foundation, QPT has three important responsibilities:

- protecting the money held by the trust,
- managing the investment of that money so it generates earnings and
- overseeing the distribution of those earnings by the charitable trusts, in the form of charitable funds for individuals and organisations in Queensland.

Acting as the trustee to important Queensland charitable trusts is one of many services QPT provides the community, including:

- offering Will-making and storage
- managing the state's unclaimed money register
- providing education on Wills, enduring powers of attorney, executorship and deceased estates.
